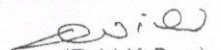
Sir,

I am directed to refer to Medical Council of India letter No. MCI-37(1)(Recog-29)(UG)/2017-Med./106147 dated 07.05.2018 on the subject mentioned above and to convey the approval of the Central Government to the recommendation of Medical Council of India for recognition of the MBBS degree awarded by the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik when granted on or after January, 2018 for increased number of seats from 50 to 100 in respect of the students of Swami Ramanand Teerth Rural Govt. Medical College, Ambajogai u/s 11(2) of IMC Act, 1956. Further, approval of the Central Government to admit MBBS students against increased intake from 50 to 100 seats at the College for the academic year 2018-19 is also conveyed.

2. The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed. The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute/Medical College.
